MUD MANIA – June 26, 2010
Volleyball Event Rules and Procedures

1. Any questions or concerns raised during the event should be voiced at the tournament table.
2. Court officials are in charge. Please adhere to any of their requests.
3. The tournament is double-elimination.
4. Teams not present at game time will forfeit their match.
5. A coin toss at beginning of the game will determine serve and side. The bottom team on the bracket will call the coin toss.
6. The score keeper will announce the score after each point.
7. Ten minutes into the game teams will change sides.
8. **Fifteen** points wins the game. If the score does not reach 15, the team with the highest score after **20** minutes of play will advance to the next round. If the score is tied at the end of twenty minutes of play the next point will win the game.
9. Clay County Parks and Mud Mania partners are not responsible for any lost or stolen items, any property damage and/or any accidents or personal injuries that may occur during Mud Mania.
10. In case of a medical emergency, a trained medical professional will be on hand at the event. Please report any injuries to the first aid station.
11. Alcohol will **NOT** be permitted anywhere on the premises. Violators will be asked to leave and teams will be disqualified.
12. Due to the possibility of sharp objects in the mud, *wearing shoes and duct tape is **MANDATORY***, if you do not have shoes or duct tape you will not be allowed to play (there will be duct tape available for purchase).
13. Jewelry will not be permitted in the mud. Please remove watches, rings, earrings, bracelets, necklaces and any other jewelry before playing.
14. Food, drinks and tobacco products will not be permitted near the mud.
15. Please use trash receptacles.
16. All children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
- 17. This is a family event – sportsmanship is encouraged.**

Play Rules for Mud Mania 2010

1. It is illegal for players to touch the net or touch an opponent.
2. Tournament is double elimination.
3. The ball can only be contacted three times by one team, before sent to the opposing team's side. No player can strike the ball more than once in succession, except for off of a tipped block.
4. No catching, throwing or holding the ball.
5. At 10 minutes teams will switch sides and continue game.
6. Game will be no longer than 20 minutes. 15 points wins game.
7. Out of bounds, **is outside of the pit**, line judges have final call. Do not argue.
8. Players **must** rotate clockwise when receiving the ball to serve.
9. Substitutes may be rotated into the game at the server's position only, unless there is an injury.
